# AMONG WHITE PHOSPHORUS AND BOMB- SHELLS

**Amnesty International** welcomes you to a seminar with **Brian Dooley**, one of Amnesty International's delegates sent on a fact-finding mission to Gaza to examine and record **human right violations in Gaza**. Weapons forbidden by international agreements such as white phosphorus were used in the Gaza War of January 2009 resulting in hundreds of casualties and extensive damages. Brian Dooley has reported on the devastation they witnessed in Gaza following the Israeli offensive with phosphorus bombshells still burning on the streets and rooftops? The Amnesty International delegates additionally detected new and unknown deadly weapons used by Israeli Forces in the conflict.

Come to Malmö University and take the opportunity to listen to Brian Dooley and discuss with us the human rights situation in Gaza and the possibilities for change. The seminar will be held in English.
